It is our hope that the 8<sup>th</sup> grade contract will eliminate any potential confusion regarding requirements for attending 8<sup>th</sup> grade year activities such as Marine Biology (SeaCamp) Fieldtrip, the 8<sup>th</sup> grade picnic, promotion and celebration. It is very important that you and your 8<sup>th</sup> grade student carefully review the contract together, sign it and return it to their classroom teacher.

## 8th Grade Year Student Contract

Eighth grade Marine Biology field trip, promotion ceremony and end of year activities are important events at RSA. As such the promotion ceremony and end of year activities are designed to honor all students, celebrate the year and acknowledge the many accomplishments of all students. To fully participate in all the activities available to our 8<sup>th</sup> graders, students must meet minimum requirements. This contract outlines the minimum academic, attendance and behavior requirements needed to participate in these activities, and are based on current RSA Board policies. Eighth graders who cannot meet these minimum requirements risk losing the privilege of participating in one or more of the following activities:

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade Field Trip: An in depth study of marine biology at Sea Camp in Monterey Bay focusing on team building, cooperation and life science content standards.
- <u>8<sup>th</sup> grade Picnic</u>: designed to allow 8<sup>th</sup> grade friends to "hangout" and enjoy the day with peers and their teachers.
- <u>8<sup>th</sup> grade Showcase</u>: developed to allow auditioned 8<sup>th</sup> graders to perform on the RSA stage before their middle school peers at the end of the year. An opportunity to be applauded and encouraged in their performing arts endeavors now and in the future.
- **Promotion Ceremony and/ or Celebration**: program to honor our graduates for their academic success at RSA before their family, friends, and staff members. During the promotion ceremony RSA performing arts classes and spring electives will honor the 8<sup>th</sup> graders by singing, playing instruments and/or dancing. A celebration party follows the ceremony.

## **8**<sup>th</sup> Grade Contract Requirements:

• **Academics**- Students must receive a 2.0 grade point average and receive a D or better in all classes including electives.

- o Failure to meet academic requirements in 2 or more classes during the first three quarters will result in the loss of Marine Biology Fieldtrip. If not attending the field trip, students will lose the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Picnic.
- o Failure to meet academic requirements in 1 or more classes during the 4th quarter trimester will result in the loss of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Picnic and the additional loss of one or more end of year activities, contingent upon the number of failing classes.
- For all academic concerns, administrative/staff discretion will be implemented and parent-teacher conferences and/or SST meetings will be employed to help resolve concerns before consequences occur.
- Attendance- Students must meet minimum attendance requirements as outlined in Board Policy and Family Handbook:
  - o 3 or more unexcused absences during the 8<sup>th</sup> grade year will result in the loss of end of year activities including but not limited to the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Picnic.
  - o Excessive tardies, an accumulation of more than 10 during the 8<sup>th</sup> grade year, that were not resolved through the SST/School Discipline process, will result in the loss of end of year activities including but not limited to the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Picnic.
- **Behavior** Students must maintain reasonable behavior. Students will be prohibited from participating in any or all of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade year activities if one or more of the following occurs during the 8<sup>th</sup> grade school year:
  - o Accumulation of 6 or more office referrals during the year or 2 during the last Quarter.
  - o Accumulation of 10 or more in-class referrals, including in-class referrals for excessive tardies, or late work.
  - o Accrual of 3 or more days of suspension during the 8<sup>th</sup> grade year.
  - o Accrual of 1 suspension day during the 4th quarter.
  - o Commitment of an act or acts that, in the collective opinion of the administration and middle school staff, warrants disqualification from one or more of the Promotion activities.
  - o Teaching staff with the concurrence of administration may disqualify a student from participating in 1 or more of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade activities when, in their opinion, the student poses a safety issue to self or others.

I have read the above contract and understand that failure to meet minimum academic, attendance, and behavior requirements may result in the loss of one or more 8<sup>th</sup> grade activities.
